

#### **COVID Vaccine Appointments - New spots on the Waiting List Available**

Between 450 and 550 appointments are scheduled weekly for those on the waiting list.

New spots on the Waiting List are available weekly on a rolling basis as people confirm their appointments.

If you would like to sign up for the Waiting List for an appointment, please check back regularly.

As individuals confirm their appointment, new spots on the Waiting List become available.

The Health Department's new appointment system provides rolling openings for residents to be placed in cue on the Waiting List to receive an appointment.

Everyone on the Waiting List is guaranteed a dose of vaccine at a Hunterdon County Health Department clinic.

The Health Department's goal is to efficiently provide vaccine to eligible recipients, while also creating an appointment system that will reduce the stress on our residents caused by the vaccine shortage.

We appreciate your patience as we continue to improve this process. We share your frustration, as the demand for vaccine exceeds the supply from NJDOH.
